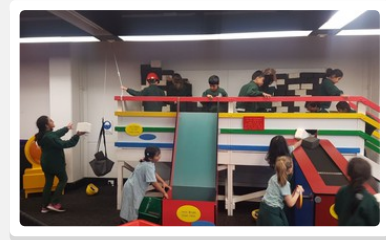

Everyone did a fantastic job for participating and represented the school well.

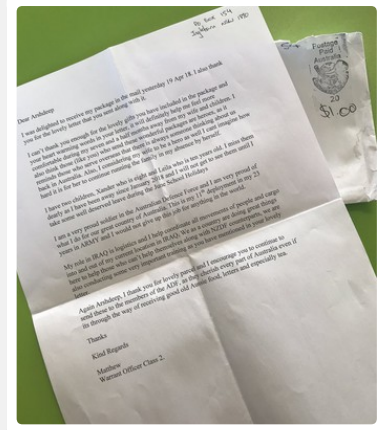

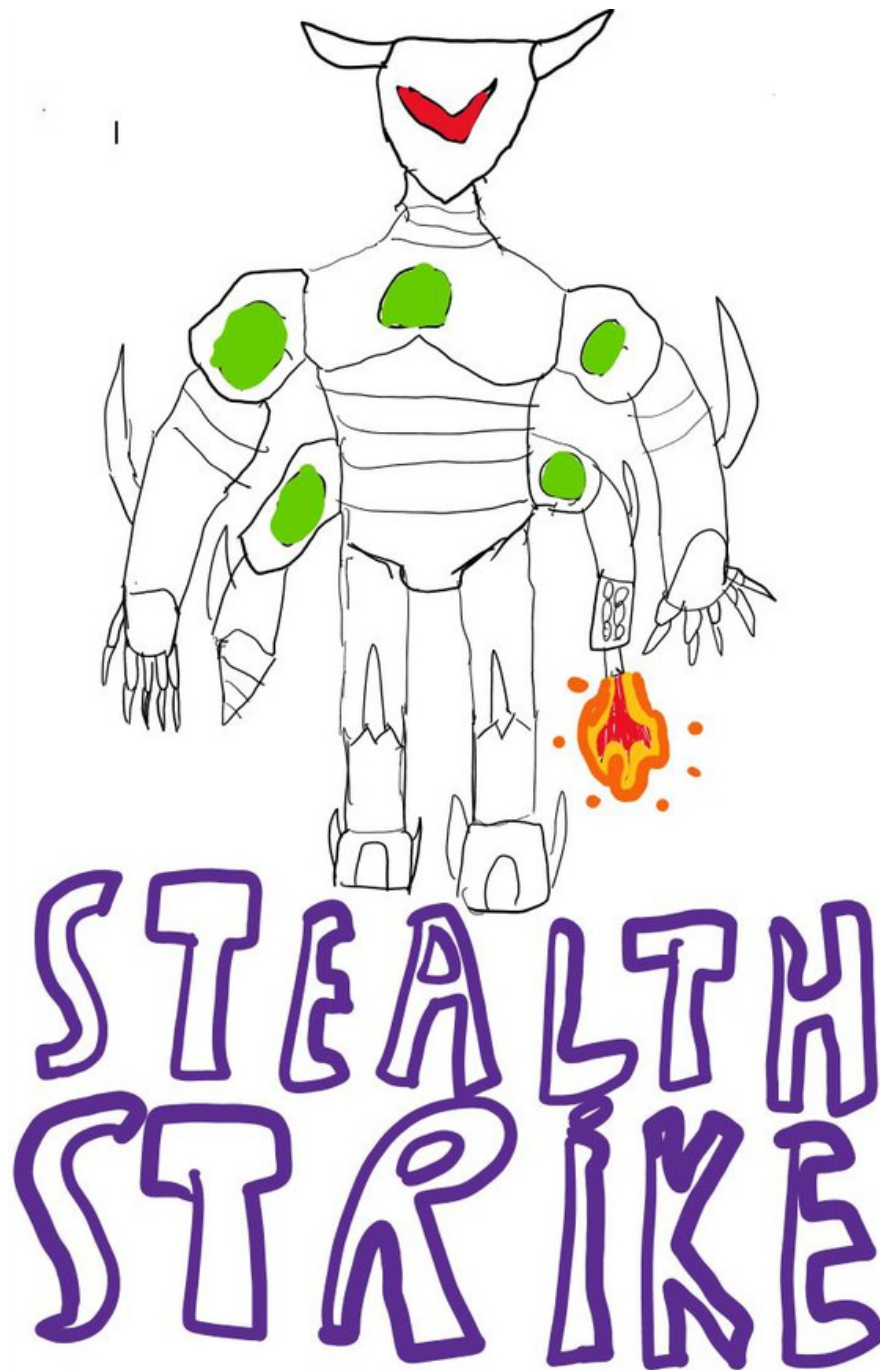


## Ryan the Future Robot Designer
